

Oral Presentation Instructions

Congratulations on being selected to present your abstract in oral form at the **XIX World Congress for the Study of Hypertension in Pregnancy** in New Orleans, LA.

The conference agenda has been posted on the ISSHP meeting website for your review (<http://isshp2014.com/index.php>). Your abstract will be included in the meeting syllabus and in the December Issue of *Pregnancy Hypertension*.

Authors must register for the conference by the conference registration deadline. Please share this information with your co-authors, as only lead authors listed as the corresponding authors are being notified. Registration information is posted on the ISSHP 2014 meeting website.

Instructions

You will have 10 minutes for your entire presentation. In general, we recommend 8 minutes of presentation, and 2 minutes of questions. There will be a timer.

There will be a speaker ready room across from the registration desk. Please bring the electronic version of your presentation to this room no later than 7 am the morning of your presentation (day before is best). This is particularly important for those using non-US media.

There will be computers in each room, so no need to bring your own computer other than for transfer of slides if needed.

New this meeting: the ISSHP will select the best clinical and the best basic science oral presentation for an award to be presented at the close of the meeting. The presentations will be judged by two judges during the hour of presentation. The selections will be based upon scientific merit, content, and presentation.
