

Poster Presentation Instructions

Congratulations on being selected to present your poster at the **XIX World Congress for the Study of Hypertension in Pregnancy** in New Orleans, LA.

The conference agenda has been posted on the ISSHP meeting website for your review (<http://isshp2014.com/index.php>). Your abstract will be included in the meeting syllabus and in the December Issue of *Pregnancy Hypertension*.

Authors must register for the conference by the conference registration deadline. Please share this information with your co-authors, as only lead authors listed as the corresponding authors are being notified. Registration information is posted on the ISSHP 2014 meeting website.

If you are shipping your poster, it must arrive at the hotel by Thursday October 23, 2014. Shipping instructions are available on the website. The poster may be claimed at the hotel business office.

Set-up time for posters: Sunday, October 26, 2014 at 1 PM to Monday, October 27 at 1:30 PM. We request that posters be available throughout the meeting. If you must leave early, please have a colleague remove your poster for you.

Poster Removal: please remove posters between 2:30 PM and 6 PM on Wednesday October 29. Any posters left after this time will be removed and no longer available.

Instructions for preparing posters:

The poster board panel dimensions are 4 feet by x 8 feet (landscape) with a neutral background. The poster does not need to be this large, but should not be any larger.

Your poster number will be listed in the final syllabus distributed onsite. **DO NOT ADD THE POSTER OR PRESENTATION NUMBER TO YOUR POSTER** as this might change just prior to the meeting. The poster should be easily read standing two feet away from the poster. At least one author, preferably the first author, should be available throughout the assigned poster period to answer questions and give a brief description of the study.

New this meeting: the ISSHP will select the best clinical and the best basic science poster for an award to be presented at the close of the meeting. The posters will be judged during the hour of presentation. The selection will be based upon scientific merit, content, and presentation.
